	Small Group Co-Leader - with a co-leader, prepare for and lead small group meetings on an on-going basis. Contact small group members periodically. This is an ongoing, relational commitment. Some preparation required (1 hour each week). Groups average meeting 2-3 times per month, typically in the homes of the leaders or participants. Meetings are about 1.5 hours.
